Without Fuelstar

Using normal unleaded petrol the fuel consumption averaged over a 3 month period was 8.2 km/litre or 12.195 litres/100km.

Using premium unleaded the fuel consumption averaged over a 3 month period was 12.3 km/litre or 8.13 litres/100 km.

The vehicle obviously ran far better on premium unleaded, but with a commensurate increase in the cost of fuel.

With Fuelstar (installed 26 May 2005)

Using premium unleaded, averaged over 3005 km the consumption was 12.3 km/litre or 8.13 litres/100, identical to that without the Fuelstar.

Using regular unleaded, averaged over 5427 km over an 8 months period, the fuel consumption was 12.8 km/litre or 7.81 litres/100km.

Conclusion

The Fuelstar reduced fuel consumption by a massive 36% (12.19 litres/100 km down to 7.81 litres/100 km) while using regular unleaded petrol.

Looking at it a different way, the Fuelstar enabled the engine to operate as well on regular unleaded as it did on the more expensive premium unleaded, without penalty for performance or loss of economy.
